

Cookie Policy

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that websites place on your device as you are browsing. They are processed and stored by your web browser, and can typically be read on your future visits.

In general, there are four types of cookies based on what purpose they serve.

- Strictly necessary cookies - These cookies are essential for you to browse the website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the site.
- Preferences cookies - also known as “functionality cookies,” these cookies allow a website to remember choices you have made in the past, like what language you prefer, what region you would like weather reports for, or what your user name and password are so you can automatically log in.
- Statistics cookies - Also known as “performance cookies,” these cookies collect information about how you use a website, like which pages you visited and which links you clicked on. Their sole purpose is to improve website functions. This includes cookies from third-party analytics services as long as the cookies are for the exclusive use of the owner of the website visited.
- Marketing cookies - These cookies track your online activity to help advertisers deliver more relevant advertising or to limit how many times you see an ad.

What type of cookies does Nativex use?

Nativex only uses the following two type of cookies for the following purposes.

- Preferences cookies- Nativex solely uses the preferences cookie to remember your set-up in the past in order to optimize the information presented to you.
- Statistics cookies- Nativex also uses third party cookie of Google Analytics for purpose of helping us understand how the website is being used. Google Analytics collects first-party cookies, data related to the device/browser, IP address and on-site/app activities to measure and report statistics about user interactions.
